Dear EN section class representatives and Anglophone section parents,

Thank you very much for attending the meeting with the UK DoE representatives last week. As promised, Richard Hoy has now supplied a breakdown of the UK seconded teachers by school and section who are due to leave between now and 2016. These figures are below. If they don't look accurate to you could you please let us know as soon as possible.

As also promised we are seeking dates for meetings with the two Luxembourg school directors to discuss local recruitment issues. Luxembourg I is offering a range of dates in early June starting the week of 3rd June. We will confirm the dates as soon as possible.

We can report some news and progress. The UK decision has now been placed on the agenda of the Education Council this week. Michael Gove, the UK Education Minister, is likely to be representing the UK at this meeting. We will keep you informed of any new developments on this front.

Information per school as follows:

Luxembourg 1

The school will have 17 UK-assigned teachers (1 nursery, 4 primary and 12 secondary) from September 2013.

This means there will be 7 unfilled UK posts:

- i) Secondary English L1/L2;
- ii) Secondary Physics and ICT;
- iii) Secondary Maths;
- iv) Secondary Maths unfilled since 2011;
- v) Primary position unfilled since 2011; and
- vi) Two Secondary History/Geography and Human Science positions unfilled since 2010.

There are no UK teachers at Luxembourg 1 due to reach the end of their fixed term contract in August 2014. Unless there are resignations or retirements the number of teachers will remain at 17 from September 2014.

1 Secondary English teacher and 1 Primary teacher will leave in 2015 and 2016 respectively on the expiry of their fixed term contract. The number of UK teachers will therefore fall to 16 and then 15 over these two years.

In summary for Luxembourg 1

September 2013 – 17 teachers
September 2014 – 17 teachers
September 2015 – 16 teachers
September 2016 – 15 teachers

Luxembourg 2

The school will have 13 UK-assigned teachers (3 primary and 10 secondary) from September 2013.

This means there will be 4 unfilled UK posts:

- i) Nursery position unfilled since 2012
- ii) 2 Primary posts
- iii) Secondary English L1/2

1 Secondary Physics teacher will leave in 2014 and 2 Secondary teachers of Geography and Economics finish in 2015. Unless there are resignations or retirements at Luxembourg 2 the number of teachers will reduce in the school to 10 teachers over these 2 years. A Primary teacher leaving in 2016 will further reduce the number of UK-assigned teachers to 9 from September 2016.

September 2013 - 13 teachers
September 2014 - 12 teachers
September 2015 - 10 teachers
September 2016 - 9 teachers
